Dear Colleagues,

On February 11th, 2017, CCS will host the Young Ensemble Showcase. This event is designed to give elementary and middle school students a memorable musical experience, and to provide teachers with an opportunity to observe, share, and learn. It will be held from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM at Santa Cruz High School.

This festival is an opportunity for your K-8 students to perform for an audience. Whether you have a choir, concert band, ukulele/recorder/Orff ensemble, or something else, we want you to share your school music program with the community! This is a non-adjudicated event and intended to highlight the strengths of your music program while giving students an opportunity to be an audience for others. To encourage high attendance, there is no participation or attendance fee.

It is clear that many or most of our elementary programs do not have formal performing groups. We encourage you to think outside the box. Perhaps there are a few students from each of your general music classes that could perform a piece they've learned in class. This is a very informal setting where anything goes! Bring a few or many... whatever you can pull together. Let's get out our classrooms and enjoy the chance to be with each other.

Each ensemble is expected to attend the entire session. You will have a 15 minute time slot to perform and the rest of the day will be spent as an audience member or participant in one of our workshops. It is likely our day will get started with the wonderful Santa Cruz High Bagpipe Corps. Ann Cleveland, a local music and Waldorf educator, will be leading a folk dance workshop. We are also working with several local performing group and have yet to decide on our last headliner.

If your ensemble receives a unanimous superior rating, you will be eligible to apply for the State Choral Festival on March 31st, 2017 at Chapman University.

His passion for music education was evident in everything he did. He was dedicated, kind, and loving. He truly cared about all of us and the work we do with our students.


